MARCH SCHOLARSHIP NEWSLETTER

DEADLINES BETWEEN: March 31, 2025 & May 15, 2025

1) Folds of Honor Scholarship - \$5,000 – 100 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a family member of US military personnel.
- B) Be enrolled or planning to enroll in a program of study at an accredited college or university, or an accredited technical or trade school program, which results in a certificate or license.

2) SM Scholarship - \$2,000 - 12 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be currently enrolled as a high school junior or senior.
- B) Be a legal resident of the United States, the District of Columbia or any US Territory.

3) Society of Women Engineers Scholarship - \$10,000 - 330 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be studying engineering or computer science full time at the collegiate level in the upcoming academic year.
- B) Have a high school GPA above 3.5 and identify as a woman.

4) Herbert Lehman Scholarship - \$12,000 - 3 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Demonstrate financial need (combined family income of \$70,000 or less).
- B) Be a graduating high school senior, a first-year student in an accredited four-year college, or a student transferring into an accredited four-year college.

5) ALPA Scholarship - \$60,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: April 1, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolling as a college freshman or already be enrolled in college.
- B) Be a child of a medically retired, long-term disabled, or deceased pilot member of the ALP Association.

6) Redefining Victory Scholarship - \$2,500 - 8 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be planning on attending a community college, university, trade school, or certificate program in the fall.
- A) Be enrolled in a public, private or parochial high school or home study program in the United States or be a dependent of U.S. military or civilian personnel in an overseas school.

7) Water Ski Foundation Scholarships - \$10,000 - 27 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be an incoming freshman through senior at a two (2) or four (4) year accredited college or university.
- B) Participate in the sport of water skiing, as a skier, rider, barefooter, volunteer, or official.

8) Distinguished Young Women Scholarship Program - \$50,000 - 50 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating high school senior interested in pursuing a college in the fall.
- B) Compete in all of these categories: Scholastics, Interview, Talent, Fitness and Self-Expression.

9) Young Women in Public Affairs Award - \$5,000 - 37 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a woman, aged 16-19, living in a Zonta district or who are citizens of a Zonta country.
- B) Show an active commitment to volunteerism.

10) Vicki Soto Memorial Scholarship - \$12,000 - 4 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a full-time senior student at an accredited 4-year high school graduating in the spring of 2025.
- B) Intend to pursue a career in education at an accredited college.

11) Chief Petty Officer Scholarship - \$5,000 – 52 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a dependent child, step-child, or a non-uniformed spouse of a US Navy Active Duty, Retired, Honorably Discharged, Reserve or deceased Chief, Senior Chief, or Master Chief Petty Officer of the United States Navy.

12) American Nuclear Society Scholarship - \$5,000 - 96 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be planning to enroll in a course of study related to nuclear science or nuclear engineering at an accredited university in the United States.
- B) Demonstrate academic excellence, leadership, career goals, and financial need.

13) Boomer Esiason Foundation Scholarships - \$10,000 - 20 Awards (Deadline: Apr. 18, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolling in college or university in the fall of 2025.
- B) Have been diagnosed with cystic fibrosis.
