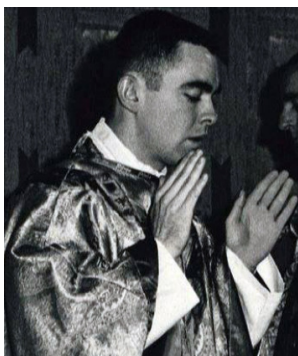
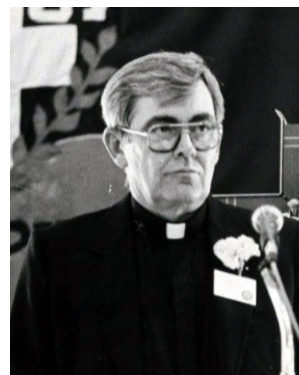
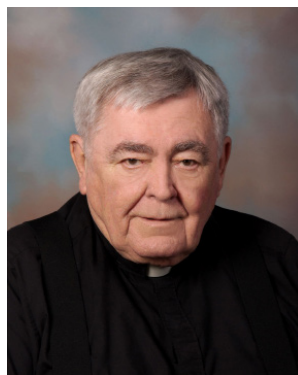


Friends of Fr. Dalton

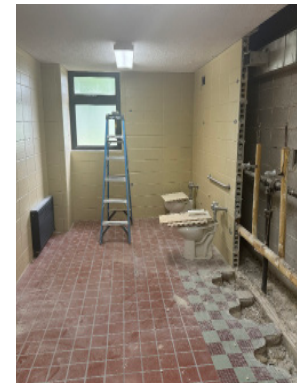
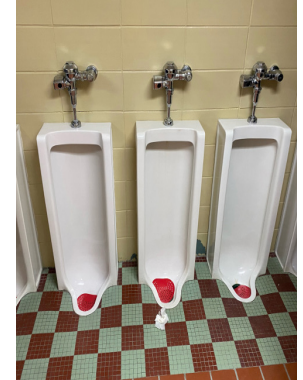

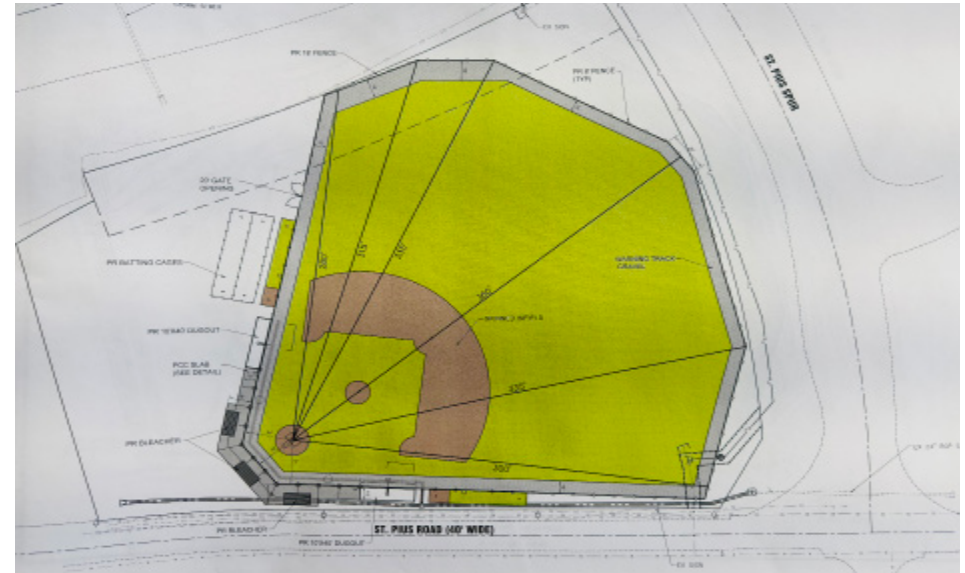
